



MIDF Provides Special Financial Assistance To Flood-Affected Smes

Kuala Lumpur, 22 January 2015 – More than 100,000 people were severely affected by the floods in several states – Kelantan, Terengganu, Pahang, Perak and Johor amongst others. The floods have not only destroyed homes and belongings but also businesses.

Malaysian Industrial Development Finance Berhad (MIDF) is offering a special financial assistance loan program with loans ranging from RM50,000/- to RM100,000/- under the SME Emergency Fund (SMEEF) for flood-affected small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in the manufacturing and services sectors. The SMEEF will assist SMEs whose businesses have been adversely affected by natural disasters such as floods, droughts, storms, beach erosion and landslides.

Through the fund, SMEs will be able to restart business operations and the assistance can be used to purchase new machinery/equipment, raw materials or stocks as well as to refurbish their premises.

The financial assistance is provided through loans repayable within 5 years and with a margin of financing of up to 90% of the costs to be incurred and at a low financing interest rate of 3% per annum. SMEs operating in an area declared as a disaster area by Majlis Keselamatan Negara need to provide evidence of the natural disaster via a letter issued by the district office or a copy of police report in order to be eligible to apply for this emergency assistance. The applicant must also possess a valid premises license issued by the municipal council.
